Each division will bowl together on a pair of lanes; example, BANTAM GIRLS representatives from all provinces will compete on the same pair of lanes, in order as shown below. The same applies for all 6 divisions. Bowlers on a Bye shift may practice on the designated Bye lanes so long as they do not disrupt the competition. **Bye Lanes are posted in the bowling centre and may change daily**. BG = Bantam Girls... JG = Junior Girls, etc.

Each shift consists of 1 game. One point will be awarded for each game won and 1/2 point for a tie game. At the conclusion of the scheduled matches, the top 3 bowlers in each division will be seeded to the stepladder (see bottom of following page for details)

STEPLADDER SEMI-FINALS & FINALS - Wednesday at 4:00pm

The top 3 placed bowlers in each division will be seeded into the Stepladder. Seeds #2 and #3 will play each other in a one game Semi-Final to determine advancement to the Stepladder Finals. In the Finals (Double Knock-Out), the #1 seed need win only one match to be declared Canadian Champion. Should the first match be won by the #1 seed, a second game will not be bowled. Should the challenger win the first match, a second match will be bowled with the winner declared Canadian Champion in that division.

SINGLES STEPLADDER

- Double Round Robin Qualifying Round determines seeds into Singles Stepladder
- #3 seed plays #2 seed in Semi-Final Match and Semi-Final Winner plays #1 seed in Final
- Challenger must beat the #1 seed twice to win the Title (Double Knock-Out Final)
- #1 seed need only win one match in the final to be declared Canadian Champion.

Breaking of Ties to determine Seed Positions in SINGLES Stepladder

Should there be a tie for #1 seed position between 2 bowlers, the tie will be broken by a review of the tied bowler's head to head matches in the qualifying round. If still tied, total pinfall through the Qualifying Round shall be used to determine the #1 seed.

A 3-way tie for #1 seed (or 4-way, or more) will see all tied bowlers in the Stepladder with seeding based on total qualifying pinfall. # 1 seed waits for the Final, with all others competing jointly for the right to advance to the Final, with the next highest semi-final score earning the Bronze medal.

A 2-way tie for the #2 seed spot will see both bowlers compete in the semi-final. The bowler's head to head matches in the qualifying round shall determine seed placing. If still tied, the high qualifying pinfall through the Qualifying Round will determine who has the option to lead off. The bowler not advancing to the Final shall have earned the Bronze medal.

A tie of more than 2 bowlers for the #2 seed spot shall see all tied bowlers compete in the Semi-Final in order of qualifying pinfall. The highest semi-final score not advancing to the Final shall have earned the Bronze medal.

If 2 or more bowlers are tied for the #3 seed position, a one-game tie breaker shall be bowled to determine a 3rd seed who shall compete against the #2 seed for the right to advance to the Final against the #1 seed. All unsuccessful bowlers in the tie-breaker fall out of the Stepladder and medal opportunities.

--- LEAD OFF ---

Stepladder matches with 2 bowlers competing will see the higher seeded bowler in the match select who leads off. In the Final, the #1 seed shall determine who leads off the 1st match. If a second match is required, the bowler who did not lead off the first match shall lead off the second match.

SINGLES STEPLADDERS SHALL BE BOWLED "TV STYLE"

The Lead-Off bowler shall bowl 1 frame on the the 10th frame with the Lead-Off bowler comleft lane of the pair to start the match. From that point on, both bowlers shall bowl 2 frames at a time starting on the right lane and moving to the left lane before the opposing bowler takes his/her turn. The match will finish off in

pleting his/her game with one frame on the right lane.

Note: Stepladders with more than 2 bowlers shall be bowled in a team lineup formation.
